Parents in conversation

Parents meet other parents and talk about parenting.

A moderator presents a topic to the rest. Elterntalk is no speech or lecture.

Mothers and fathers exchange views about their experiences of a parenting topic.

Procedure

A host or a hostess invites four to eight mothers and fathers to his/her house.

These parents talk and exchange about their parenting.

A moderator, even mother or father joins them. She or he brings suggestions concerning that talk.

But Elterntalk is no lecture. Parents exchange views about their parenting questions.

They bring own experiences and their own know-how, they are experts in one own's account.

Parents get best suggestions for their parenting from other parents.

One talk takes around two hours. For the parents who are part in that talk no costs arise.

If you wish, Elterntalk can be offered in various languages.

Mothers and fathers can become a hostess or a host.

Message an Elterntalk-Team in your area; there you get all necessary contacts to a moderator in your area. Talk and arrange a topic and try to find a common appointment.

Then invite four to eight parents to your house and the talk begins.
